tCHF is now accepting applications for 3 full-time EFL Teachers to teach beginning, intermediate, and advanced EFL classes. Two curriculums are to be taught; a six month and twelve month program. The six months syllabus will be offered to those students who have attended an English course previously and are comfortable in the use of the language in speaking, reading and writing. The one-year set of courses is to be offered to students requiring greater proficiency in the English language. Assessment of their proficiency to enter either the six months or twelve months program will be done during the selection process. The EFL requirement is a prerequisite to a newly created Accredited Technology program for students at the College level at the American University in Les Cayes, Haiti. The students will be pre-selected from several local universities to enter the program. The students' primary languages are Creole and French.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS for EFL Teachers:

- Equivalent U.S. Bachelors degree;
- minimum of two years experience teaching English as a second or foreign language in a university or an accredited language institute
- University Course study in English
- must be fluent in speaking, reading and writing both English and Haitian Creole;
- knowledge of and experience managing computer aided language learning software; and current knowledge of the latest developments in technology
- ability to interact effectively with students from diverse backgrounds
- good understanding of Haitian culture and reality
- ability to contribute to the development of the program, while being a good team player and have the ability to get along well with others

PREFERRED QUALIFICATION: Content expertise in a field related to General Education classes.
